Noppa –Backup is a static copy of Noppa and enables student access to the course material even after Noppa is taken out of service, starting from 4.1.2016. The course homepages in Noppa include e.g. course descriptions, course news, schedules, material related to teaching, assignments, and other materials, as well as course results.

How to log in
