Sustainability coordination and follow-up was moved from Campus service to Research and Innovation services with new working group including representatives from key services and ACRE; August 2015

Research and learning have been given more emphasis and to encompass all areas social responsibility has been given stronger status in working group.

Learning;

- Identification of sustainability goals in bachelor and master programs to evaluate the starting point was completed Jan/Feb 2016

- Negotiations with teacher education team ongoing; how to include sustainability to teachers pedagogical education (meeting March 7th).
- Sustainability to become theme in teaching partner – course
- Join content creation for materials for teachers on sustainability with TEK (completed earlier) and SITRA (on-going) -projects
- Reporting amount of sustainability and social responsibility courses and examples of educational activities (data collected)

Research

- Opening up Aalto's research themes connectedness to social responsibility, sustainability and global challenges in e.g. Ministry of Education reporting
- Early discussion with research projects teams on including evaluation on social responsibility and sustainability to project planning processes internally, first on partner evaluation (March/April planned)
