## 1. Submitting a file to a Turnitin activity in MyCourses

### a) Course assignments

### b) Thesis drafts

- Bachelor's thesis: see if you can submit draft versions in a Turnitin activity in your bachelor's thesis seminar. If not, see point b).
- Master's or doctoral thesis (or bachelor's thesis):
  - check whether your advisor or supervisor has got a personal MyCourses workspace for thesis supervision in [mycourses.aalto.fi](https://mycourses.aalto.fi) or advisor's (sur)name in the "Search courses" (=magnifying glass icon) field. If the search lists a workspace beginning with "The" ending with your supervisor's or advisor's name, follow the instructions in the workspace in order to submit your thesis in a Turnitin workspace is not listed, [you can suggest your supervisor to get one](#). If it did not work, see the point c).
